All customs offices are authorised to accept ATA Carnets during their normal office hours except from ports and airports in the occupied areas of the Republic of Cyprus, i.e. the ports of Famagusta, Karavostasi and Kyrenia, or the airport in Tymbou (so-called "ERCAN").
