ATA Carnets are accepted for transit under the following conditions:

- To cover transportation, through the Customs territory of goods exported under the provisions of the ATA Convention from the country where the Carnet was issued to another country.
- To cover the transportation, from the Customs office to an inland office, of goods to be declared at the inland office for temporary admission under cover of the ATA Carnet.
- To cover the transportation from the inland Customs office to the frontier one, of goods previously declared at the inland Customs office for reexportation under cover of the ATA Carnet.

ATA Carnets are not accepted for postal traffic.
